The role of Logistics Operator in BAE Systems (Submarine Solutions) involves ensuring all areas/departments within the Company are supplied with resources when and where required. A huge range of equipment from Stationary to large pieces of machinery and sections of the boat would all be included in this task. Individuals would be expected to liaise with internal and external customers meaning that various methods of communication skills would be needed (email, verbal and telephone skills) to meet all customer demands while keeping to stringent time scales.



Further education will include a First Certificate in Engineering and 5 key skills, both qualifications at Level 2. Units will be gained from the Performance Engineering Qualification.

You will attend college one day a week on day release at Furness College. A NVQ 2 in Technical Services is also a requirement in the Logistics role.

Throughout your apprenticeship you will be given opportunities to partake in extra curricular activities such as the Apprentice Innovation Challenge this is run in association with the UK's partner charity who present a mechanical and electrical challenge to our apprentices throughout the UK. There is also the Company Ambassadors scheme, where individuals get the opportunity to go back to their former school and pass on experience and knowledge which has been gained while working in BAE Systems.

Further Education is actively encouraged by the Company and individuals will be given the opportunity to further their studies Those showing outstanding commitment and promise will be fully supported and qualifications leading up to degree level are attainable.
